CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

In almost every case, leather and suede garments will alter in some way through a cleaning process. Leather and suede garments are often not designed for solvent or water cleaning, but it may be necessary on occasion to keep them fresh and extend their life. We have the most advanced knowledge and technology to wet or dry clean your garment, however, you must be clear about the following before submitting your garment. -:

Leather skins may contain natural weakness which is cosmetically masked during tanning. Your garment may contain a tick bit or scar tissue camouflaged with a filler.

Other weaknesses produced by tanning include:

- Bellies (thin skin) which contains wrinkles
- Weak areas and veins
- Glues – some glue used in seams may weaken and even leach into the garment leaving a “leaching effect”.

When a garment with poor bonding or filler is immersed in solvent during cleaning, the adhesive may soften and can leave a staining in effect or expose weaknesses beneath. These characteristics cannot be determined prior to dry cleaning.

Solvent soluble pigments may also lose some colour during cleaning. To avoid colour variations, all matching accessories need to be cleaned together with the garment.

Zips, body lining and pocket lining may rip with the weight of the jacket during the cleaning process, this is dependent on factors such as age and the manufacturers’ workmanship.

Ad Astra does not accept responsibility for outcomes resulting from solvent incompatibility to; variation of colour, relaxation shrinkage, button/ornament damage, manufacturing/tanning techniques of from characteristics shown by general wear and tear.

These properties are rare and a recognised care label gives you some assurance that the garment will clean safely.
